Five Fundamentals Of Our Faith

There are five fundamentals of the faith which are essential for Christianity, and upon which we must agree:

- 1) The Deity of our Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus being God in human flesh the second person of the Godhead. (John 1:1; John 20:28; Hebrews 1:8-9).
- 2) The Virgin Birth. (Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:23; Luke 1:27).
- 3) The Blood Atonement. The once and for all sacrifice of Jesus dying for our sins. (Acts 20:28; Romans 3:25, 5:9; Ephesians 1:7; Hebrews 9:12-14).
- 4) The Bodily Resurrection. (Luke 24:36-46; 1 Corinthians 15:1-4, 15:14-15).
- 5) The inerrancy of the Holy Scriptures themselves. (Psalms 12:6-7; Romans 15:4; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:20)

Our Basic Expectations

We want Rock Haven Staff to be examples of how Christ wants each of us to live. Christ should be glorified in everything we do! Our staff does not condone, or personally use drugs, alcohol, tobacco ("chewing and dipping" included), pornography, homosexuality, or participate in pre-marital sex, either on or off duty. We expect you to commit to these standards as well. Luke 17:2 says "It would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck and he were thrown into the sea, than that he would cause one of these little ones to stumble."

We want to have an environment of complete honesty. It is a more enjoyable environment when we know that all members of the staff are loyal to each other as well as the camp. Your first loyalty is to God. Your second loyalty is to us. All staff members agree to first confront the staff member and then immediately report any deviation of the camp rules, policies, and practices by campers or staff members to the Director for prayerful and loving consideration and action on their behalf.

Our staff is expected to dress in a conservative manner. Swim suits must be modest one piece only. Shorts must be athletic and not too short (no cheer or running shorts). Body piercings, earrings and tattoos are subject to the Camp Director's discretion and may be asked to be covered or removed if deemed inappropriate.
